[Statement of claim]

The Plaintiff's claim is for £12,732.23 together with interest as pleaded below being money due and owing to it from the Defendant in respect of goods purchased from the Plaintiff by the Defendant from the Plaintiff's depot in Lancaster on diverse dates during April and May 1995 on the Defendants credit account with the Plaintiff. Full particulars of which have been delivered to the Defendant and exceed three folios.

On the 12th May 1995 the Defendant tendered a cheque payable to Booker Cash & Carry on its account with National Westminster Bank Plc, Scunthorpe branch in the sum of £3,000.00 in part payment of the debt due to the Plaintiff. The said cheque was returned unpaid and marked "account closed". Further, on the 24th May 1995 and 26th May 1995 the Defendant tendered two further cheques in the sum of £3,000.00 each payable to the Plaintiff in part payment of the debt due to the Plaintiff, drawn on the Defendants bank account with Lloyds Bank Plc Lancaster Branch. Those cheques too were returned unpaid marked "refer to drawer". Notice of dishonour of the said cheques were given by the Plaintiff's letter addressed to the Defendant and dated 6th June, 1995.

In addition the Plaintiff claims interest on the said sum of £12,732.23 at 8 per centum per annum from the date hereof until payment pursuant to section 35A of The Supreme Court Act 1981. The daily rate of interest is £2.79.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the amount claimed and £180.25 for costs and, if the Plaintiff obtain an order for substituted service, the additional sum of £43.00, further proceedings will be stayed.
