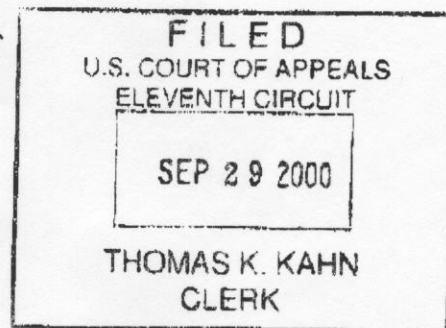

PER CURIAM:

In this appeal, appellants challenge the district court's evidentiary rulings at trial (before the court), the court's decision regarding the weight and credibility of the testimony of appellants' accountant, Luis Ovidio Rodriguez Brandao (testimony that appellants contend was uncontroverted), and the court's conclusion that appellants had not made out a claim for libel because appellants had failed to establish that appellees were negligent in publishing the disputed statements.

We find no merit in appellants' challenges and therefore affirm the district court's judgment for appellees.

AFFIRMED.
