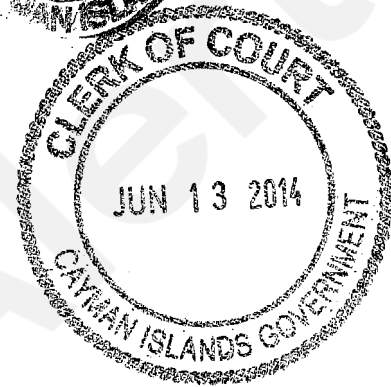

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

GENERAL INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff's claim is for:

1. The Plaintiff was employed by the Defendant on/or around 1 April 1989; the said employment was re-affirmed by a written agreement (the "**Employment Agreement**") on/or around 12 July 2011. The Plaintiff was the Group Assistant Managing Director and Company Secretary for a non-fixed term.
2. By letter dated 31 January 2014 the Defendant summarily terminated the Plaintiff's employment without giving the required notice of 12 months, or payment in lieu of notice, both of which were required under the Employment Contract.
3. As a result of the Defendant's wrongful dismissal of the Plaintiff, the Plaintiff has suffered loss and damage including damages for pay in lieu of notice, unpaid contractual bonuses, loss of profit participation, interest pursuant to section 34(1) of the Judicature Law (2013 Revision) at such rate from such date and on such amount as this Honourable Court thinks fit, costs, and such further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court deems appropriate.
